I am writing in response to your email dated 27<sup>th</sup> December 2018 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding cardiac physiology.

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q3 Please can you confirm the professional reporting lines for Cardiac Physiologists within your organisation?







- A3 The Trust has five band 8a Cardiac Physiologists. (One is appointed as Head of Department). The Head of Department is managerially accountable to the Directorate Manager of the Heart Centre and clinically accountable to the Consultant lead for Cardiac MR, a further four are appointed as clinical leads for sub-specialities
- Q4 Does your organisation have any other forms of recruitment and retention premiums or incentives for attracting other staff groups? This could include 'golden handshakes' or other salary uplifts/incentives
- A4 The Trust follows National Terms and Conditions for Agenda for Change staff.

For Consultant Medical Staff, where there have been two prior unsuccessful attempts at recruitment, the Trust can pay up to £6000 per annum for completion of every year, for up to three years.
