I am writing in response to your email dated 29th July 2019 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding additional questions to Foi ref 163-1920 and DNA's.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Please could you clarify the data slightly to help with our understanding – and ensure we are collecting the same data across all NHS Trusts? (Previous FOI ref 163-1920)

- The first covering the time period 1st January 2015 31st December 2015
- The second covering the time period 1st January 2016 31st December 2016
- The third covering the time period 1st January 2017 31st December 2017
- The fourth covering the time period 1st January 2018 31st December 2018

It would be helpful to know:

- i. For each time period, how many DNAs there were but only among patients who were attending their first appointment
- A1 Please see below for DNA's: First Appointments
 - 1st January 2015 31st December 2015 = 22964
 - 1st January 2016 31st December 2016 = 25014
 - 1st January 2017 31st December 2017 = 28409
 - 1st January 2018 31st December 2018 = 29638

Q2 Could you also say how many of the DNA patients who were attending their first appointment (those in (i)) above) did the Trust discharge?

- A2 Please see below:
 - 1^{st} January 2015 31^{st} December 2015 = 21280 (discharged from the service)
 - 1^{st} January 2016 31^{st} December 2016 = 23192 (discharged from the service)
 - 1st January 2017 31st December 2017 = 19115 (discharged from the service)
 - 1st January 2018 31st December 2018 = 19350 (discharged from the service)
