I am writing in response to your email dated 11th April 2019 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding elderly discharges.

On the same day we contacted you via email as we required the following clarification: For question 3 is this all Discharges or just those aged 65+ and do you want totals by month for the Discharge destination i.e. Home, Rehab etc. with no age breakdown?

You replied via email:

"I don't need an age breakdown on the destination".

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 I'm looking for the number of people aged 65+ who were discharged between 22.00 and 06.00, for each month between January 1 2018 and December 31 2018.
- A1 Please see below: please note that at UHNM we count discharges between both hospital sites.
