I am writing in response to your email dated 25th July 2018 (received into our office 26th July) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding number of staff employed at the Trust.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 I am writing to you to request the following information from the Trust under the Freedom of Information (FOI) Act 2000 (the Act);

An estimate of the population the Trust's remit covers.

We provide a full range of general acute hospital services for approximately 900,000 people living in and around Staffordshire and beyond. The Trust also provides specialised services, such as Trauma, for three million people in a wider area, including neighbouring counties and North Wales.
