I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 28th January 2025 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Insulin Pump

I would like to know the number of adults and children with Type 1 diabetes currently registered with the diabetes teams at your hospitals, on the date you obtain the data (I know it will update frequently)

I would also like to know how many patients you have on each of the below pumps for both adults and pediatrics.

Ypsomed Medtronic Omnipod Tandem T Slim

I would also like to know how many of these are on a Hybrid Closed Loop system (optimal care as per NICE TA)

A1 There are currently 5,984 patients on the adult diabetes waiting list. It is not possible to provide the numbers separately as our Clinical Information System does not capture this information separately.

I can neither confirm nor deny whether the information you have requested is held by the Trust in its entirety. This is because the information requested in your question is not held centrally but may be recorded in health records. In order to confirm whether this information is held we would therefore have to individually access all health records within the Trust and extract the information where it is present. We therefore estimate that complying with your request is exempt under section 12 of the FOI Act: *cost of compliance is excessive*. The section 12 exemption applies when it is estimated a request will take in excess of 18 hours to complete. We estimate that accessing and reviewing all health records and then extracting relevant information would take longer than the 18 hours allowed for. In addition to the section 12 exemption the Trust is also applying section 14 (1) exemption: *oppressive burden on the authority*.
