I am writing in response to your email dated 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019 (received into our office 18<sup>th</sup> January) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding trainees and compliance with HEE guidance. I sincerely apologise for the delay in responding.

On 18<sup>th</sup> January 2019 we contacted you via email as we required clarification on your meaning of "trainee" and what you meant by "how many times were trainees moved from one department to another outside of their planned work schedule/rota"

On the same day you replied via email the following:

"The trainees means trainee doctors (junior). A trainee is assigned to a specialty for a certain period. The request is to know if they are moved to a different speciality. I hope that helps?"

As of 1<sup>st</sup> November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- The request is in reference to trainees and compliance with HEE guidance.
   How many times were trainees moved from one department to another outside of their planned work schedule/rota between December 2017 and March 2018 (inclusive)?
- At UHNM we would not ordinarily ask a trainee to work in a different department to another outside of their planned work schedule/rota, however we have collated the following information from records that we have.
  - In March 2018 1 NICU Registrar covered General Paediatric due to a vacancy
- Q2 How many times were trainees moved from one department to another outside of their planned work schedule/rota between December 2018 and the date of this email (inclusive)?
  - i) Of these, how many of the departments to which trainees were moved had declared Operational Pressures Escalation Level 4 (OPEL 4)?
- At UHNM we would not ordinarily ask a trainee to work in a different department to another outside of their planned work schedule/rota, however we have collated the following information from available we can confirm that there were four (4) x general surgery/urology.
