I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 19th August 2024 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding histology/cellular pathology.

Q1 We are researching the practice of histology/cellular pathology in NHS organisations, specifically focusing on outsourcing of reporting activities and including the use of locums.

For the period 2023, June 1st to 2024, May 30th, (12 months in total) please provide the following information:

- 1. How many full-time equivalent histopathology consultants (as defined by being on the GMC specialist register for pathology) were employed by the authority at 30/05/2024?
- A1 There were 16.5 WTE consultants in post, all based at the hub laboratory at RSUH, with 5.0 FTE vacancies (across all subspecialities).
