I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 25th April 2024 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding insourcing

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 Can you provide me with the following please;
 - a. Which framework does the Trust use for the procurement of Insourced Clinical Services.
 - b. Who is responsible for the procurement of Insourced Clinical Services at the Trust. i.e. Name or Job Title within procurement.

To confirm, Insourcing is clarified as subcontracted out services by specialist providers and this is not the same as locum supply or "off framework agency supply".
