## What does the PRIDE Rainbow Flag represent?



Bisexual	Bi is an umbrella term used to describe a romantic and/or sexual orientation towards more than one gender		Androgyne	Ambiguous sexual identity or combining of masculine or feminine external manifestations of gender expression
Pansexual	Pansexuality is sexual, romantic, or emotional attraction towards people of all genders, or regardless of their sex or gender identity		Gender fluid	A person is gender-fluid when they don't identify solely as male or female, and their gender identity changes over time
Non Binary	People whose gender identity doesn't sit comfortably with 'man' or 'woman'. Non-binary identities are varied and can include people who identify with some aspects of binary identities, while others reject them entirely		Gender queer	The term genderqueer means someone who does not follow binary gender norms. They may be non-binary, agender, pangender, genderfluid, or another gender identity
Trans	Trans is an umbrella term to describe people whose gender is not the same as, or does not sit comfortably with, the sex they were assigned at birth		Neutrois	Neutrois is a non-binary gender identity that is usually associated with gender neutrality or the nullification of gender
Asexual	A person who does not experience sexual attraction. Some asexual people experience romantic attraction, while others do not		Aromantic	A person who does not experience romantic attraction. Some aromantic people experience sexual attraction, while others do not
Intersex	A term used to describe a person who may have the biological attributes of both sexes or whose biological attributes do not fit with societal assumptions about what constitutes male or female. Intersex people may identify as male, female or non-binary		Demisexual	Demi is an umbrella term used to describe people who may only feel sexually or romantically attracted to people with whom they have formed an emotional bond. People may also use terms such as gay, bi, lesbian, straight and queer in conjunction with demi to explain
Gay Men	Refers to a man who has a romantic and/or sexual orientation towards men. Also a generic term for lesbian and gay sexuality		Demi romantic	the direction of romantic or sexual attraction as they experience it
Lesbian	Refers to a woman who has a romantic and/or sexual orientation towards women. Some non-binary people may also identify with this term		Polyamorous	To be polyamorous means to have open intimate or romantic relationships with more than one person at a time
Polysexual	A polysexual person is someone who is sexually and/or romantically attracted to multiple genders. It is not the same as being bisexual or pansexual, although all of these sexualities involve being attracted to more than one gender		Straight Ally	A (typically) straight and/or cis person (Someone whose gender identity is the same as the sex they were assigned at birth) who supports members of the LGBT community
