I am writing in response to your email dated 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Medical Examiners.

## Q1 I would like to enquire as to what the setup of the Medical Examiners office for your organisation.

## What hours is the service operational?

- A1 Office opening hours are Monday-Friday 8am-5pm, Weekend 8am-12pm including bank holidays.
- Q2 What staffing arrangements do you have during weekends (staff type & hours worked)?
- A2 Medical Examiner Officers Saturday 4 hours and Sunday 4 hours (extra day off given in the week for working weekend, with enhanced pay) Medical Examiners – on-call rota (to work as and when needed for an urgent release)
- Q3 What work is undertaken during weekends? i.e. is full scrutiny completed for all deaths or are only deaths for urgent release scrutinised?
- A3 Medical Examiner Officer MEO pre-scrutiny work and identifying doctors to complete MCCD all cases. Medical Examiners scrutiny and sign off, of MCCD for urgent releases.
