If we are referring to the largest overspend on agency versus the budgeted expenditure, then this will be in Nursing and Midwifery Registered staff group, which is 18% overspent, against the agency budget as of Month 6 of the current financial year. The highest agency charge rates for this staff group ranges between £37 per hour to £52.50 per hour, depending on the day of the week, and whether it's a day or night shift.
