I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 11th October 2024 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding car park

Q1 Through the Freedom of Information Act, I make the following request relating to hospital parking charges.

I request the total amount of car parking revenue collected by University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust across the Royal Stoke University Hospital and County Hospital, in Stafford. I request the information for the 2023/24 financial year. Specifically for 2023/24, I would also like to know:

A: A site-by-site breakdown of how much has been paid to park at Royal Stoke and County Hospital by patients and visitors.

B: A site-by-site breakdown of how much has been paid to park at Royal Stoke and County Hospital by staff.

A1 See below:

- a) £2,451,729.04. The Trust Car Parking Contractor provided this information however this has not been split into sites. As the information is not held by the Trust, we are unable to assist further.
- b) £957,842.97. The Trust Car Parking Contractor provided this information however this has not been split into sites. As the information is not held by the Trust, we are unable to assist further.

Q2 Specifically for 2023, I would like to know:

How many vehicles have been issued with parking fines at the Royal Stoke in 2023.
