I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 26th January 2024 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Iron Infusion

On 29th January 2024 we contacted you via email with the following: To continue with your request we require clarification on the following:

Q1 is this referring to after usage (qty)?

On the same day you replied via email with:

'how many (quantity) times have iron extravasations been reported within each year for the past 10 years (if possible)'

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 I am writing an academic paper and I would be grateful for some information about iron (IV) infusions and iron extravasation.

None of the information I will be given, if used, will not be attributable to a specific organisation/s.

How many iron extravasations have been reported within your organisation, if possible, could I have a 5- or 10-year breakdown?

We are unable to provide the information you require in the requested format as to release this data could lead to the identification of the person(s) involved due to the low numbers involved, and would breach the Trusts obligations under Data Protection Act 2018. Accordingly, this aspect of your request is exempt from disclosure under the terms of Section 40(2) of the FOI Act. *Personal information*. However as the Trust is committed to openness and transparency we can band the numbers as being <5

This exemption is an absolute exemption and therefore no consideration of the public interest test is needed.
