Virtual MDT for Breast OAFU patients

A virtual MDT (VMDT) will be conducted for all patients who are almost 5yrs post treatment and are due for discharge with the aim of agreeing suitability for discharge and to review treatment plans for any patients prescribed anti endocrine treatment. Patients who have a medication switch planned during the first 5 years may also be discussed. The VMDT will take place on the 1st Friday afternoon in the month. The current plan is to run this VMDT once a month but is subject to change based on demand.

The VMDT will require the presence of an Oncologist (as per agreed rota) an Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP) Breast Care Nurse (BCN) and Macmillan Breast Care Navigator. The ANP/BCN will present the case summary and the Navigator will document the outcome on to iPortal. The patient and GP will be advised of the VMDT outcome by the ANP/BCN by letter.
