I am writing in response to your email dated 8th May 2019 (received into our office 9th May) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Hip and Knee Prosthesis contracted providers.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

Q1 Who are your contracted Hip & Knee Prosthesis contracted providers

- A1 Stryker Ltd and Smith & Nephew Ltd
- Q2 What are the current contract dates including extensions for your Hip & Knee Prosthesis Procurement
- A2 1 January 2017 to 31 December 2020
- Q3 What is your chosen procurement route and who is your procurement partner (if applicable) for Hip & Knee prosthesis purchase
- A3 Total Orthopaedic Solutions, Framework is currently managed by Tower 4 CPP
- Q4 What is the contract value (£) agreement & market share for hip replacements with your current providers
- A4 Please see below;
 - Contract value £3.5M
 - Stryker 66% market share
 - Smith & Nephew 34% market share
- Q5 What is the contract value (£) agreement & market share for knee replacement procurement with each your current providers
- A5 Please see below;
 - Contract Value £2.2M
 - Stryker 92% market share
