I am writing in response to your email dated 23rd May 2018 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding systems. I apologise for the delay in responding.

The Trust must do its utmost to protect patient and staff information. Patient information and staff information are the foundations upon which healthcare is built, and the Trust has a clear responsibility to safeguard this information to ensure we are able to provide the necessary care to our service users. I can confirm that the information you have requested is held by the Trust, however some of the information requested in your question is exempt from disclosure under section 24(1) which states "Information which does not fall within section 23(1) is exempt information if the exemption from section 1(1) (b) 2 is required for the purpose of safeguarding national security." Furthermore withholding this information is also supported by the Freedom of Information Amendment (Terrorism and Criminal Intelligence) Act 2004. In addition to the above exemptions, section 38 "health and safety": "endanger the safety of any individual" also applies.

Under section 16 of the FOI Act we are required to provide requestors with advice and assistance where possible. We would therefore like to advise you that if your request is shortened to exclude "version" we are able to comply within the 18 hour time frame. In order to avoid delay to your response we have provided this below.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.
