I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email 9th January 2025 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding Prevent Training

**Q1 I am writing to request the following information relating to your NHS Trust's training materials, specifically:**

- **A copy of all training materials, or similar, issued to staff by your Hospital Trust relating to PREVENT since 1/1/23**

**A1 There are two levels of PREVENT training:**

- Basic Prevent Awareness
- Prevent Awareness

The basic level is covered within our Safeguarding Adults Levels 1 and 2 eLearning (slides attached).

Safeguarding Adults Level 3 briefly mentions Prevent (slide attached).

The higher level of training which is sometimes referred to as Health WRAP is provided via <https://www.elearning.prevent.homeoffice.gov.uk/mentalhealth>

There is also a module provided by eLearning for Health: Preventing Radicalisation - Awareness of Prevent (Level 3) which is available via the eLearning for Health website, but also accessible via our ESR Learning Management System.
