I am writing to acknowledge receipt of your email dated 1st July 2021 (received into our office 2nd July) requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000) regarding waiting list.

As of 1st November 2014 University Hospitals of North Midlands NHS Trust (UHNM) manages two hospital sites – Royal Stoke University Hospital, and County Hospital (Stafford). Therefore the response below is for the two sites combined from that date where appropriate.

- Q1 Please can you tell me how many patients have been removed from waiting lists at the Trust because they have died, for each of the following years?
 - a) 2021 to date
 - b) 2020
 - c) 2019
 - d) 2018
 - e) 2017
- A1 I can confirm that the Trust holds information regarding how many patients have been removed from waiting lists, but feel this information is exempt under section 21: *information reasonably accessible by other means*. - b) For Cataract Surgery, there are no current restrictions / limitations to the number of referrals that the Trust receives.
- c) The Trauma Directorate do not have any policies limiting the number of referrals for any procedures; there is no limit to the number of Hip and Knee replacement referrals.
